

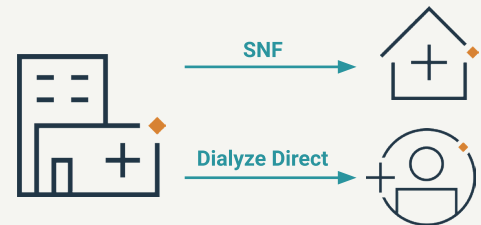
# Quick reference guide Dialyze Direct

Dialyze Direct is now live with **CarePort Intake** and **CarePort Referral Management** to enable hospitals and health systems to coordinate dialysis treatment in skilled nursing facilities (SNFs), helping to reduce readmissions and improve conditions for patients with end-stage kidney disease and chronic kidney disease.

This document explains how the case manager utilizing a CarePort discharge planning solution can coordinate Dialyze Direct's on site dialysis treatment for patients.

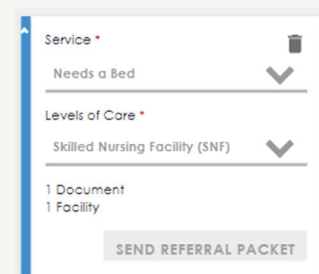
## Sending the patient referral

To send patient referrals for both levels of care seamlessly, look for the corresponding Dialyze Direct listing to match the SNF where the patient is being placed. Dialyze Direct will receive the referral via CarePort Intake or CarePort Referral Management to provide Dialysis (in SNF) services for the patient.



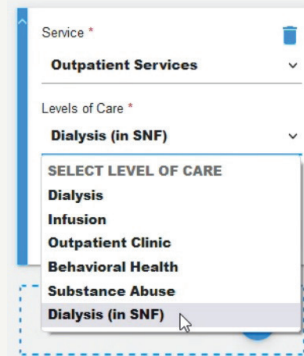
## Searching for a SNF with On Site Dialysis in CarePort Discharge

1. Select service: Needs a Bed
2. Level of Care: Skilled Nursing Facility
3. Click "Key Services Network" and select "Dialysis (on site)"
4. Send referral to SNF



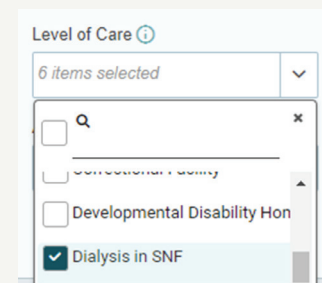
## Searching for Dialyze Direct in CarePort Discharge

1. Search “Outpatient Services” as the service type
2. Select “Dialysis (in SNF)” as the level of care
3. Send referral to Dialyze Direct



## Searching for a SNF with On Site Dialysis in CarePort Care Management

1. Create a Skilled Nursing Facility Referral
2. On the Choose Recipients page, open the Level of Care filter
3. Select “Dialysis in SNF”
4. Send referral to SNF



## Searching for Dialyze Direct in CarePort Care Management

1. Search “Dialysis in SNF” as the referral type
2. On the Choose Recipients step, select the applicable Dialyze Direct - SNF location that matches where the initial SNF referral was sent
